## Connecting your Android device to the wireless

### Notes

All staff and high school students are automatically granted permission to connect their personal devices to the BulldogNet wireless network. Middle school and elementary school students must receive permission from their respective principals before they are granted access to connect.

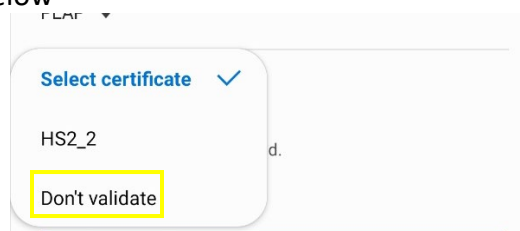
Follow the instructions given below to connect your Android device to the BulldogNet wireless network. If you are experiencing issues, the technology staff unfortunately cannot provide assistance.

### Steps


1. Unlock your device and go to the “Settings” application
2. Tap on the Wi-Fi section in settings and let your device search for wireless networks. You should see the same networks that are shown in the screenshot below



3. Once the wireless networks appear on your screen, tap on BulldogNet which is also highlighted in the screenshot above
4. Leave the EAP method set to “PEAP”. Tap the “CA certificate” menu and select “Don’t validate” as shown in the screenshot below



5. Enter your BulldogNet username (**not email address**) in the “Identity” field and your password in the “Password” field as shown below
