Connecting your Chromebook to the wireless

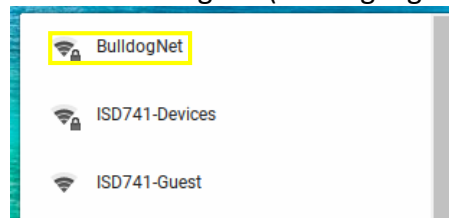
Notes

All staff and high school students are automatically granted permission to connect their personal devices to the BulldogNet wireless network. Middle school and elementary school students must receive permission from their respective principals before they are granted access to connect.


Follow the instructions given below to connect your Chromebook to the BulldogNet wireless network. If you are experiencing issues, the technology staff unfortunately cannot provide assistance.

Steps

1. Log in to your device and click the status bar  located in the bottom right corner of your screen
2. Click on the network bar located above the Bluetooth bar in the menu that pops up
3. You will see a list of networks, click on BulldogNet (also highlighted below)



4. In the next window that pops up, select PEAP under the EAP method drop down menu
5. Enter your BulldogNet username in the identity box and password in the password box (be sure to **not** input your email address in the Identity box and do not fill out the “Anonymous Identity” box) – do not change any of the other fields or enter any more information than your BulldogNet username and password
