Connecting your Mac to the wireless

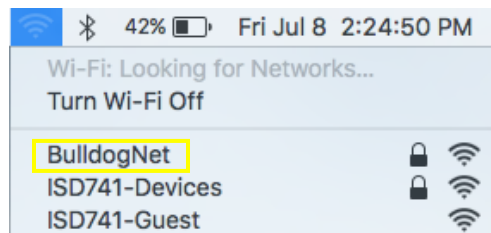
Notes

All staff and high school students are automatically granted permission to connect their personal devices to the BulldogNet wireless network. Middle school and elementary school students must receive permission from their respective principals before they are granted access to connect.

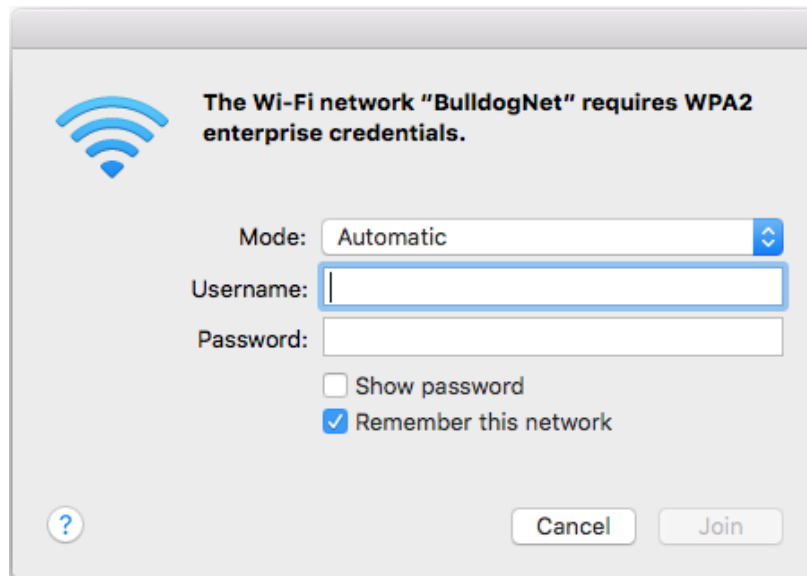
Follow the instructions given below to connect your Mac to the BulldogNet wireless network. If you are experiencing issues, the technology staff unfortunately cannot provide assistance.

Steps

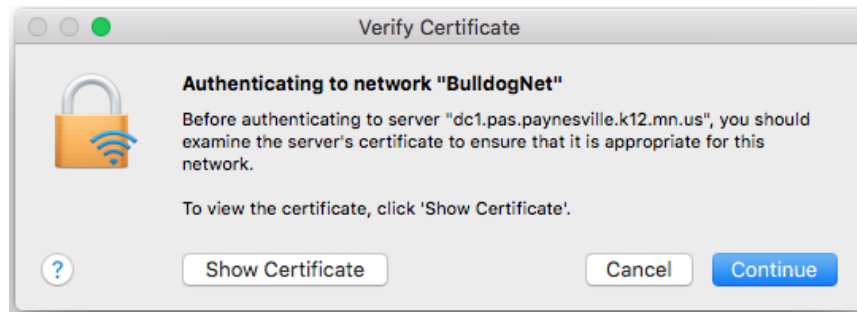
1. Log in to your device and click the Wi-Fi icon  located in your menu bar
2. After a few seconds, your device should show a list of wireless networks like the ones shown in the screenshot below




3. Once the wireless networks appear, click on BulldogNet which is also highlighted in the screenshot above



4. It will then ask you for a username and password (as shown above). Enter your BulldogNet username and password in their respective fields (be sure to **not** input your email address in the username box, leave the dropdown menu above the credential boxes set to Automatic and make sure the Remember this Network box is checked)
5. Once you've entered your credentials, click the Join button located on the bottom right of the window



6. As shown above, a window will pop up asking you to Verify Certificate, click the "Continue" button
7. Enter your user account password for your Mac if prompted
8. Click the Wi-Fi icon  that is located in your menu bar again, and if you see a checkmark next to BulldogNet like the screenshot shows below, you are connected and will automatically connect when you enter the building
