## Connecting your iOS device to the wireless

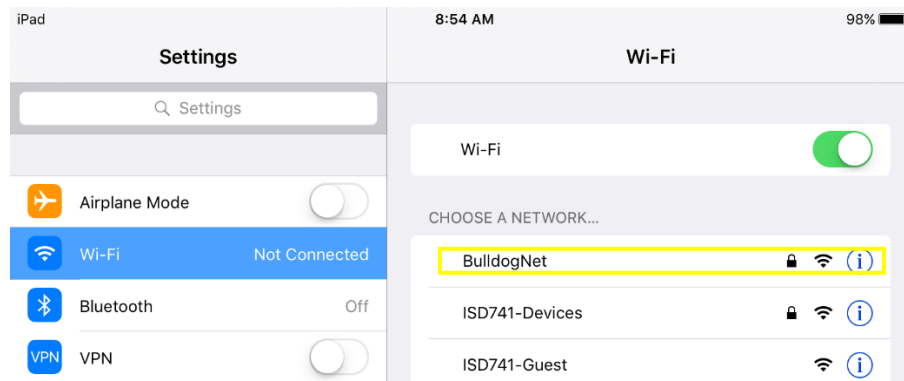
### Notes

All staff and high school students are automatically granted permission to connect their personal devices to the BulldogNet wireless network. Middle school and elementary school students must receive permission from their respective principals before they are granted access to connect.

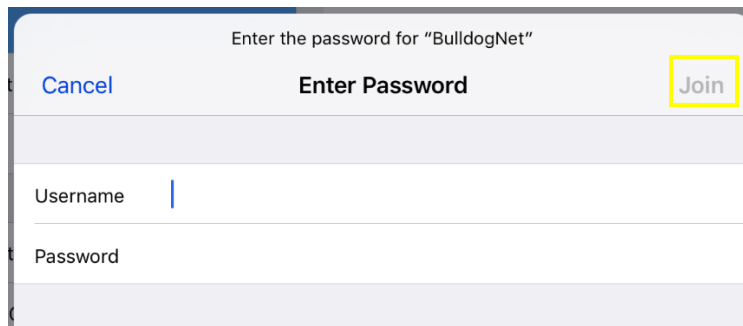
Follow the instructions given below to connect your iOS device to the BulldogNet wireless network. If you are experiencing issues, the technology staff unfortunately cannot provide assistance.

### Steps

1. Unlock your device and go to the “Settings” application
2. Tap on the Wi-Fi section in settings and let your device search for wireless networks. You should see the same networks that are shown in the screenshot below



3. Once the wireless networks appear on your screen, tap on BulldogNet which is also highlighted in the screenshot above



4. It will then ask you for a username and password (shown above). Enter your BulldogNet username and password in the respective fields. (be sure to **not** input your email address in the username box)
5. After entering your credentials, tap the “Join” button located on the top right (also highlighted above)
6. A new screen will show (screenshot on next page), asking you to trust a certificate. Tap the “Trust” button located on the top right of the screen to continue



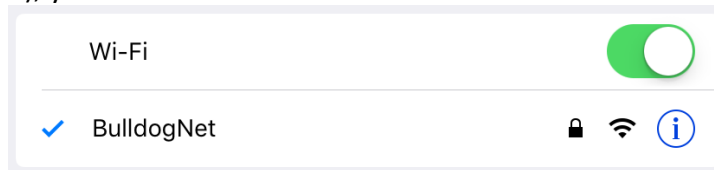
