
BulldogNet VPN iOS connection

Notes

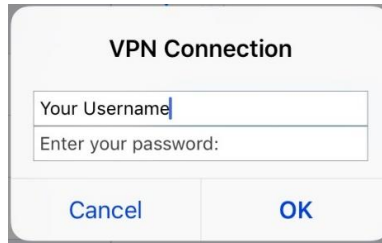
Use the instructions below to set up BulldogNet VPN access on your iOS device. You must receive permission from Jonah to be able to use our VPN service. If you do not request permission, your account will not have VPN access rights. **DISCONNECT YOUR DEVICE WHEN YOU NO LONGER NEED REMOTE ACCESS.**

Steps

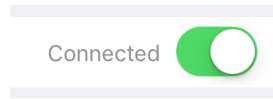
1. Unlock your device and go to the "Settings" application
2. Go to General>VPN and tap the "Add VPN Configuration..." button
3. In the menu that appears, tap the "Type" menu and change it to IPsec and then go back
4. Fill out the fields shown using the information below:
 - a. Description: BulldogNet
 - b. Server: bnvpn.paynesville.k12.mn.us
 - c. Account: *Your username (enter your BulldogNet username in this field)*
 - d. Password: Leave blank
 - e. Use Certificate: Leave off
 - f. Group Name: Leave blank
 - g. Secret: #741vpn
 - h. PROXY: Leave to "Off"

5. Tap "Done" when you finish filling out the fields as directed above
6. To connect, turn on the VPN slider switch next to "Not Connected"
7. It will ask you for a password like shown below, enter your BulldogNet password to connect



8. You are successfully connected when the "Not Connected" turns to "Connected" and there is a VPN icon at the top of your screen



9. To disconnect, go to the "Settings" application and turn off the VPN slider next to "Connected" in General>VPN or under "Wi-Fi"
